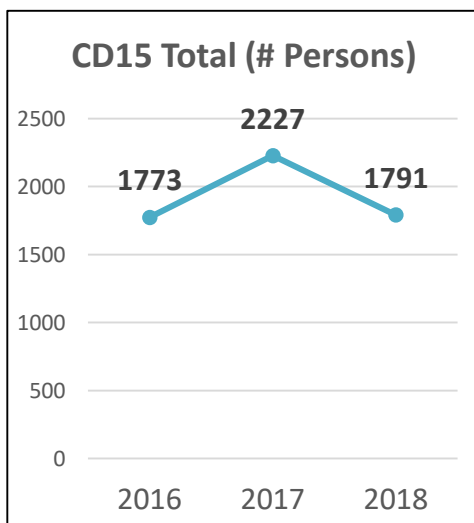
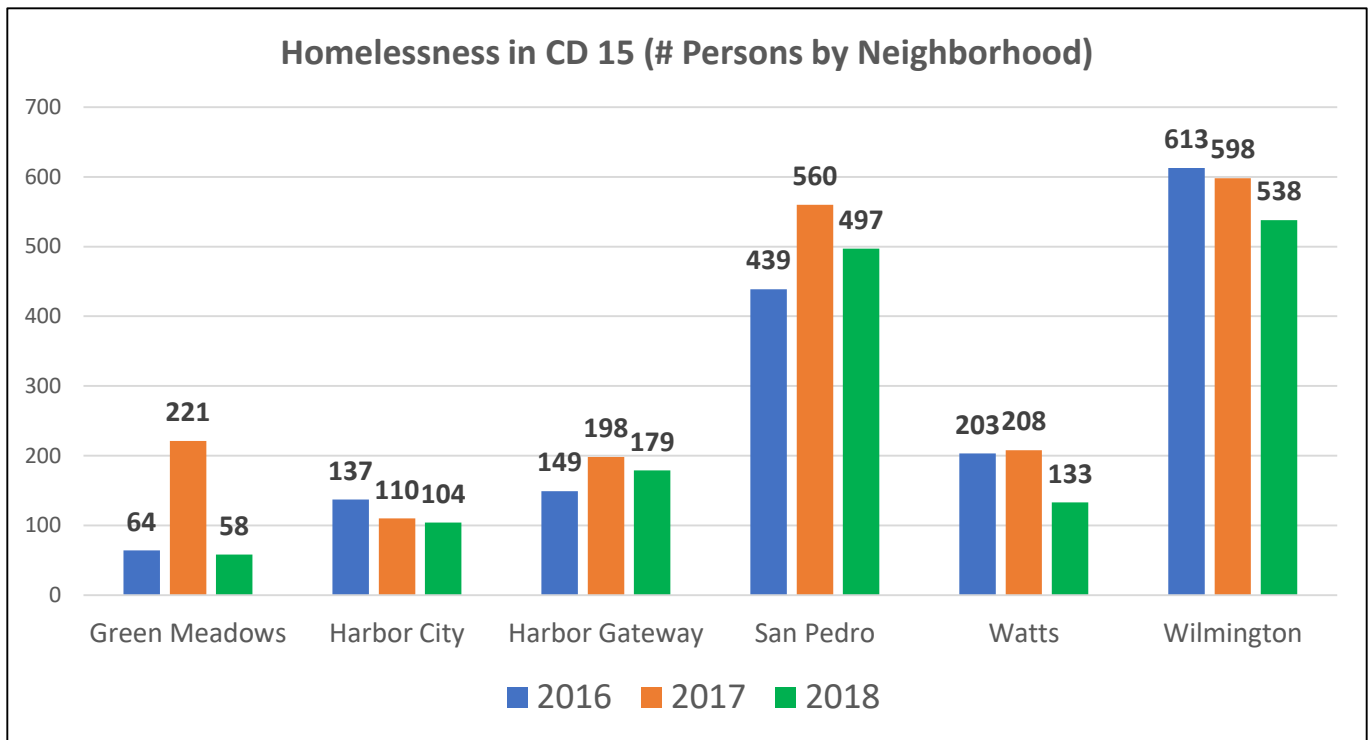

Notes About These Graphs

Note 1: These neighborhoods are located:

- Entirely within SPA 6/South LA: Green Meadows, Watts
- Entirely within SPA 8/South Bay: Harbor City, Wilmington, San Pedro
- In both SPAs 6 and 8: Harbor Gateway

Note 2: Green Meadows is part of Harbor Gateway but is listed separately

Note 3: In 2018, Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority (LAHSA) reported the following at the SPA level: Domestic Violence Shelter stays, DPSS-issued Motel Vouchers (considered “Emergency Housing”), and Youth Count data. To be consistent, SBCEH pulled these results from the 2016 and 2017 city level results. Therefore, this information is not reflected in the city level data above for any year.

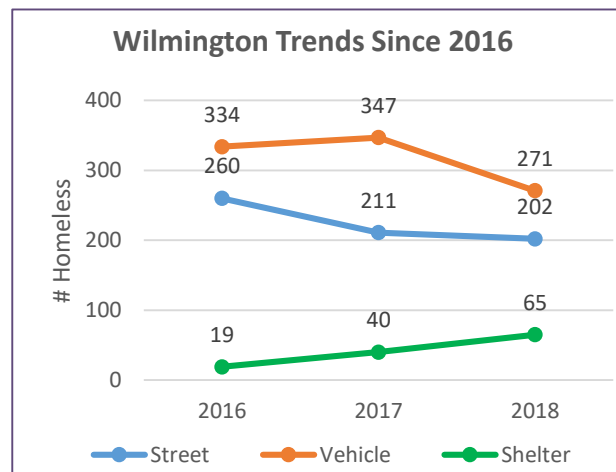
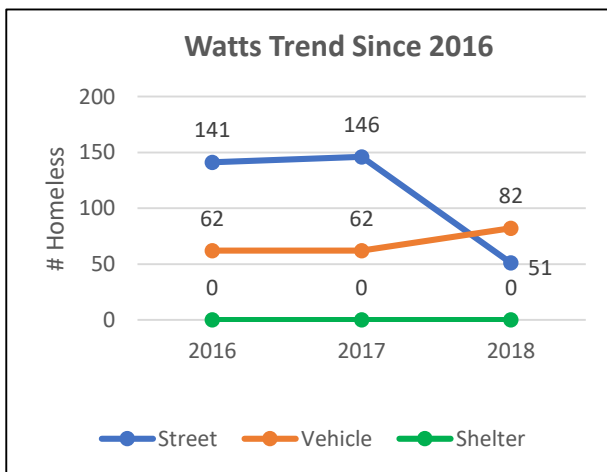
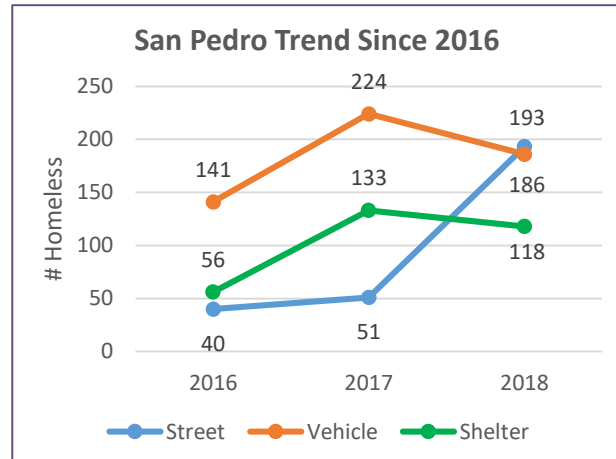
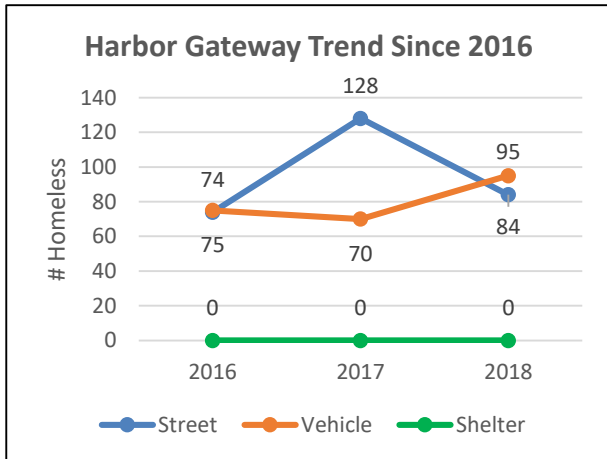
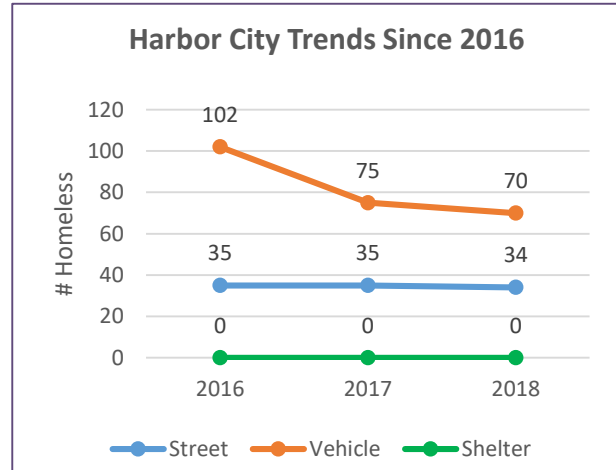
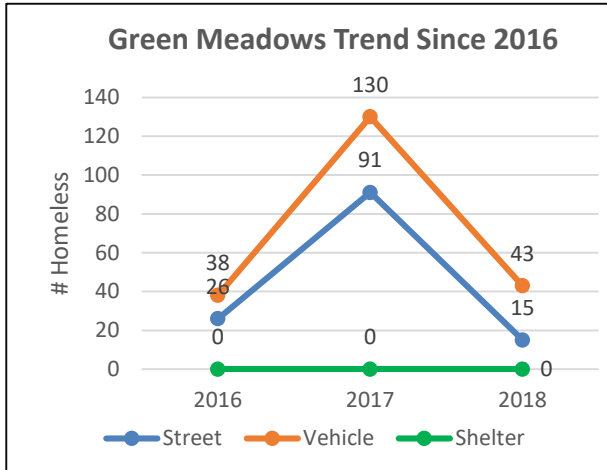
Note 4: The CD15 Total graph to the left reflects the total number of persons experiencing homelessness, including all the populations described in Note 3.
