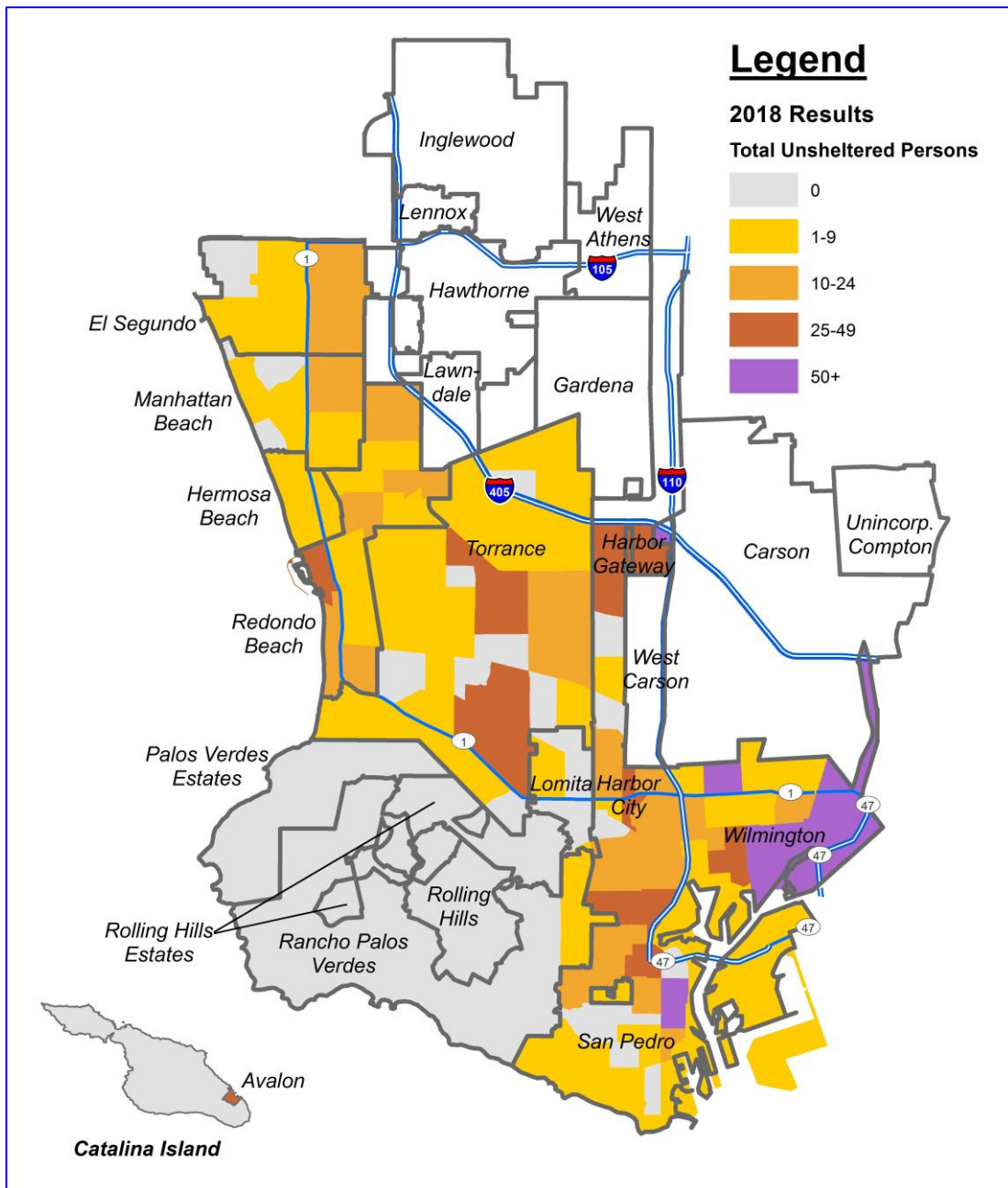

### 43% of persons experiencing homelessness in SPA 8 were in SD 4

- Homelessness declined by 9% in this geography, lead by fewer people in the Los Angeles City neighborhoods (down by 115 persons, or 8%).
- Living in vehicles continues to lead where people are experiencing homelessness, though there was a decline this past year (down by 149, or 15%).
