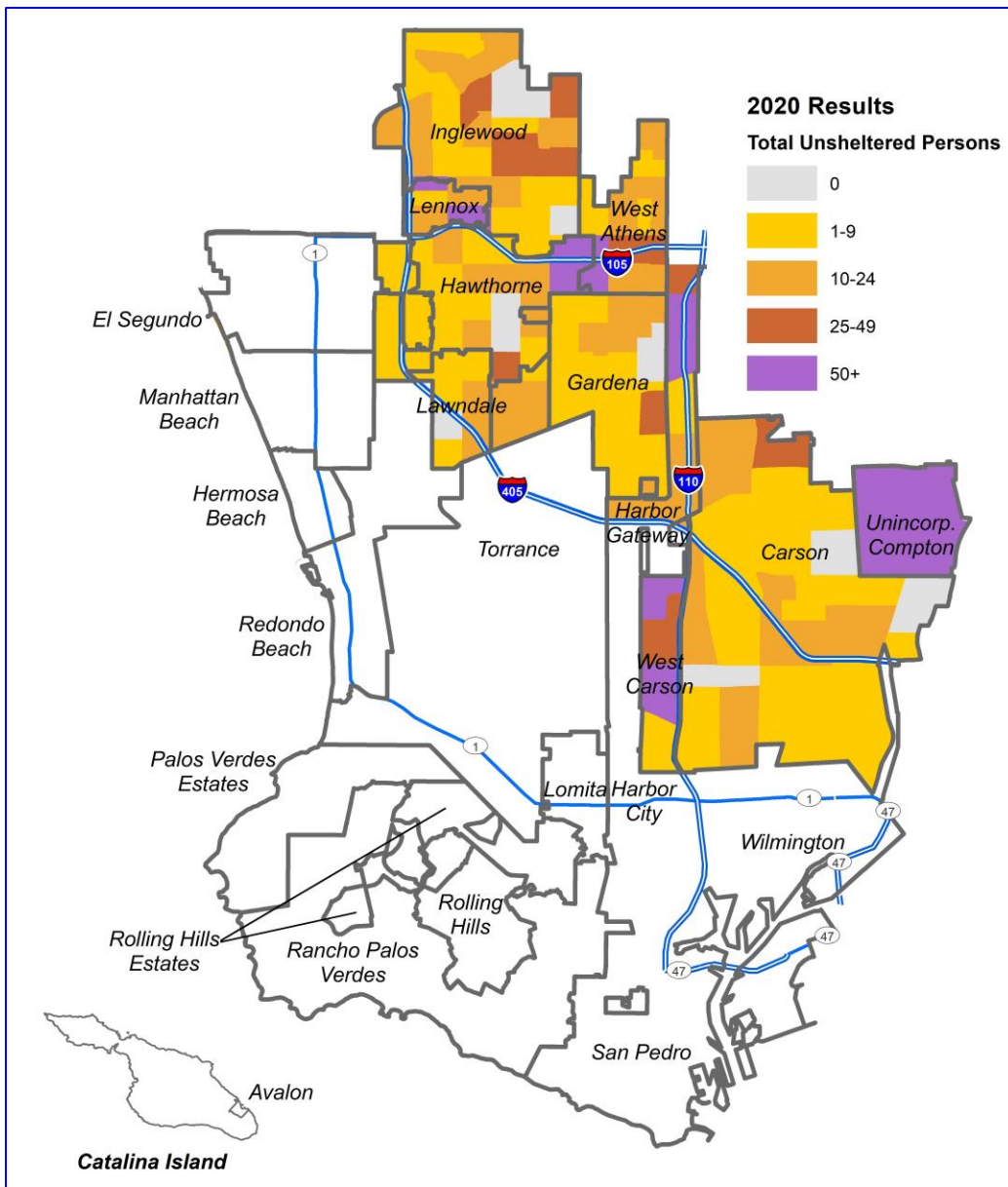

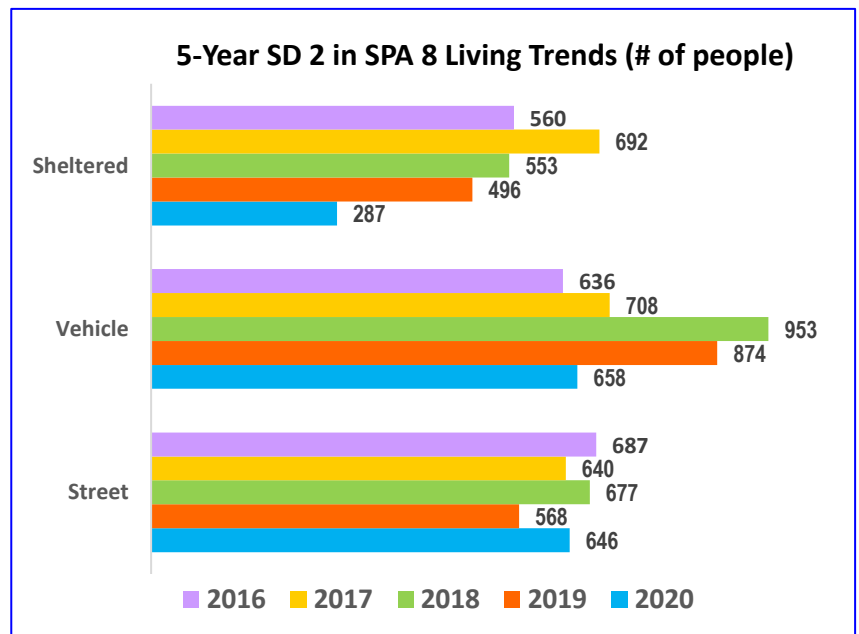

**41% of persons experiencing homelessness in SPA 8 were in SD 2**

- The overall decrease was due to the -25% drop in persons staying in vehicles and the -42% decline in those sheltered at US Veterans Initiative/Inglewood.
- One-third (34%) of the unsheltered population in SD 2 live in unincorporated areas.



- Notes**
- SBCEH rounds the component elements of the Homeless Count differently than LAHSA so the overall community total may not match.
  - In 2019, LAHSA changed the city/neighborhood boundaries and then retroactively applied these to the 2016-2018 Counts. The table and graph reflect the original Count results reported for these years and hence may be different from LAHSA's Community data.
  - Some data that LAHSA reported at the SPA Level is not included in this report. This includes: Domestic Violence Shelters and Youth Count results.
