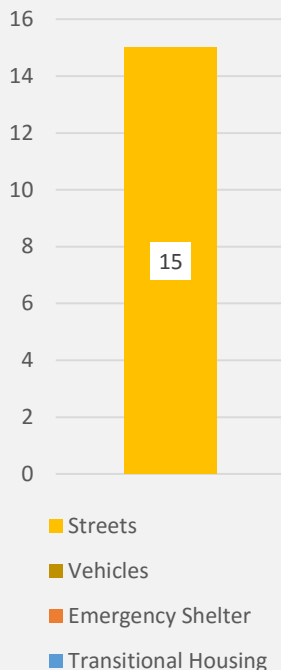

- The remaining 5 persons were living on the streets of Avalon.

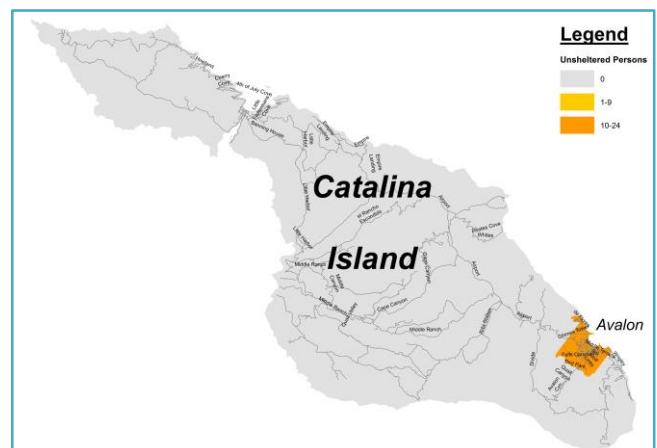
