

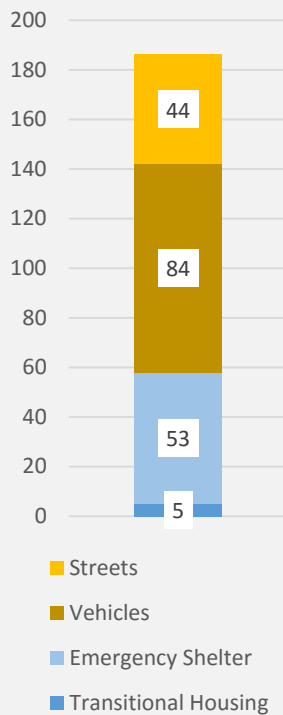

Total Persons 186

- Persons in unsheltered situations were found in all of Gardena's census tracts.
- The LA County Department of Public Social Services issues motel vouchers which are considered emergency shelter beds. On the night of the Count, 53 were used. In 2016, this program was newly assigned to Gardena. Without considering them, overall homelessness rose 125% (from 59 to 133).

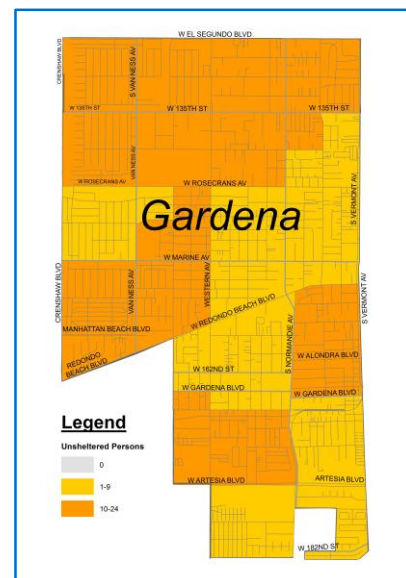
