

## San Pedro (City of Los Angeles) 401 Homeless Persons on January 27, 2016

- In 2013, San Pedro's unsheltered homelessness was clustered around Gaffey St. In 2015 and 2016, the concentrations shifted east to Pacific Ave. and Harbor Blvd.
- Note: Due to an administrative matter, persons in transitional housing were not included in this year's count for San Pedro.


