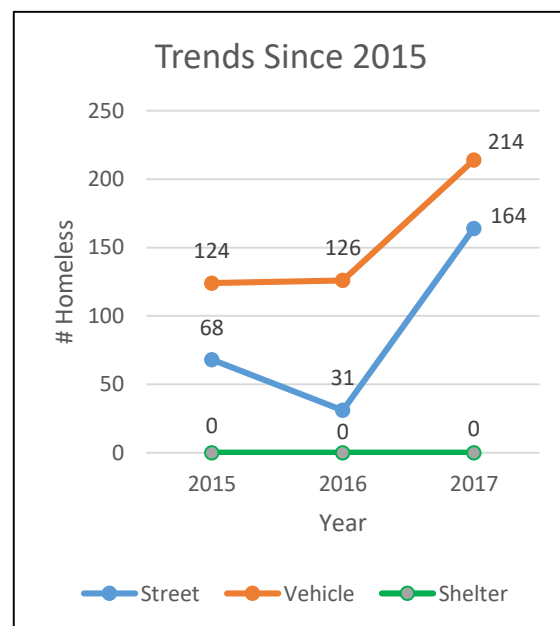
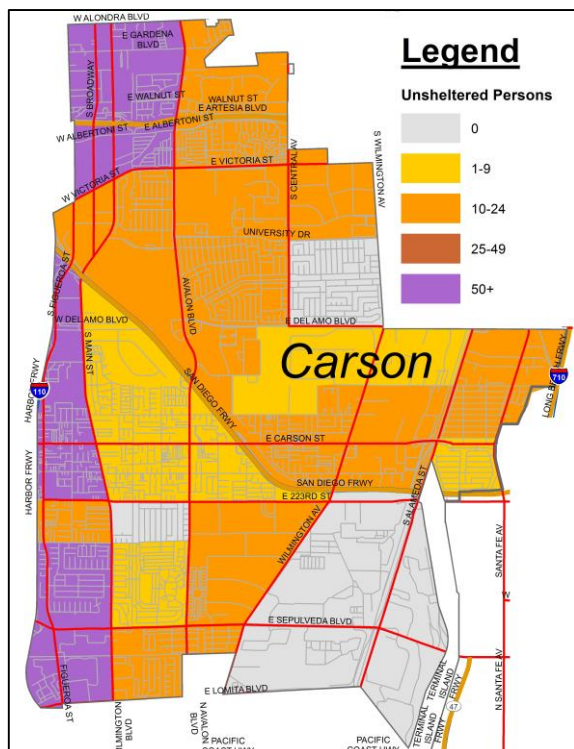

Fast Facts

- Street homelessness rose 429%, primarily because of a large encampment where over 100 persons were residing.
- Two census tracts were added back into Carson's 2017 Count, where 25 were experiencing homelessness.
- Vehicular homelessness rose by 70% this past year.
