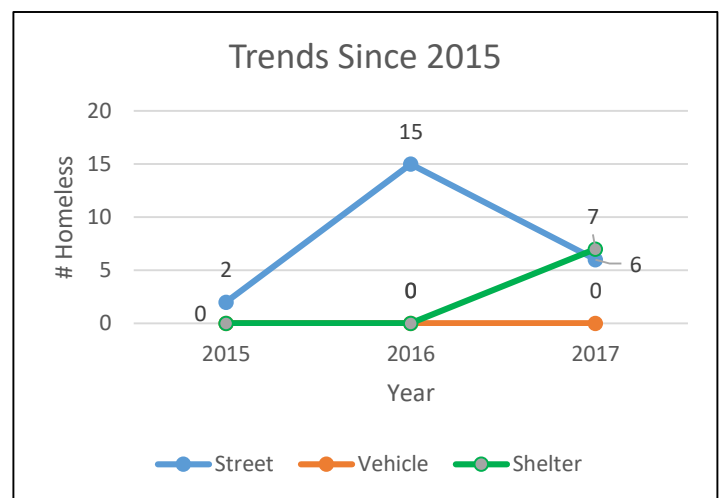
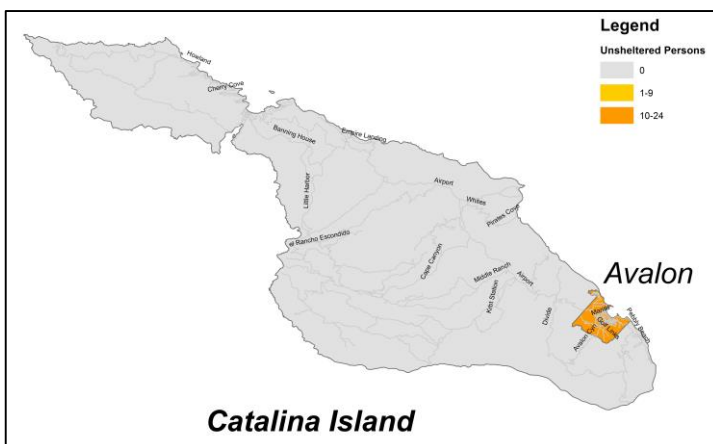
Catalina Island, Including Avalon 13 Persons Experiencing Homelessness on January 25, 2017
