

Fast Facts

- Street homelessness decreased by 81%.
- Vehicular homelessness rose 450%.
- Among the combined South Bay beach cities, homelessness rose in 2017:
 - ...by 20% from 2016 (260 to 312)
 - ...by 55% from 2015 (201 to 312).
