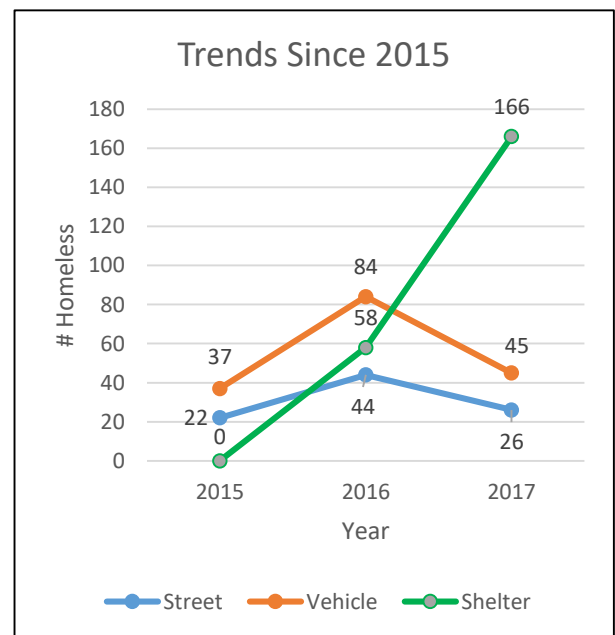
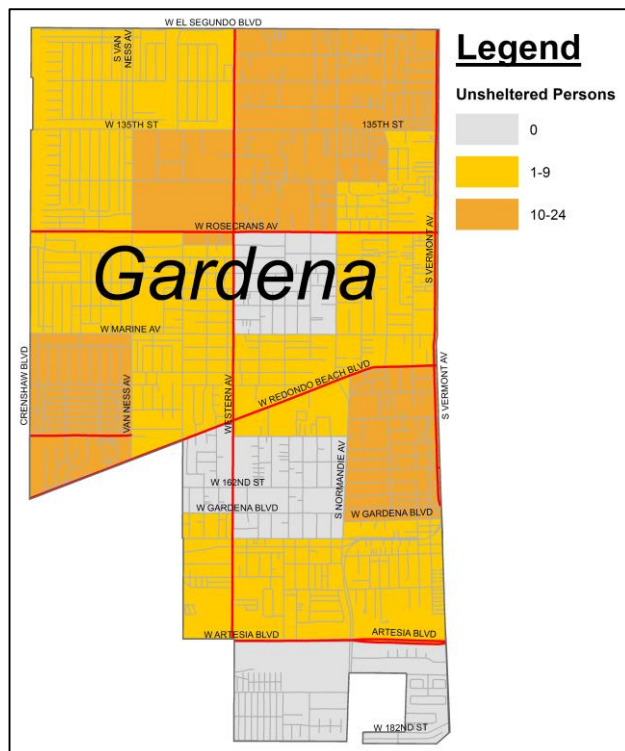

Fast Facts

- Gardena is one of the few South Bay cities having a significant decrease in its unsheltered total, down by 45%
- The large increase in the shelter number is due to the use of County DPSS motel vouchers (53 to 161), from a 204% increase.
- When these motel vouchers are factored out, Gardena's overall homelessness decreased by 43% (133 to 76).
