



Fast Facts

- Inglewood's overall 33% decline is primarily driven by the decrease in shelter bed stays, from 287 to 127.
- In 2016, the County operated a winter shelter hosted at this city's Armory. It was only operational that year.
- Unsheltered homelessness remained relatively unchanged, decreasing by 3%.
