
Redondo Beach 261 Persons Experiencing Homelessness



Fast Facts

- Overall homelessness in Redondo Beach rose 21% from last year and 58% from 2015.
- Persons found experiencing homelessness in vehicles rose by 111% this past year.
- Among the combined South Bay beach cities, homelessness rose in 2017:
 - ...by 20% from 2016 (260 to 312)
 - ...by 55% from 2015 (201 to 312).
