



Fast Facts

- Vehicle homelessness continues to rise:
 ...from 2016 to 2017: 59% increase
 ...from 2015 to 2017: 132% increase
- ➤ For the 2016 Homeless Count, one transitional shelter's occupancy was not available as in previous years. This data was collected for the 2017 Count.
- ➤ 33% of the South Bay's homelessness is in the City of Los Angeles (1,421).
