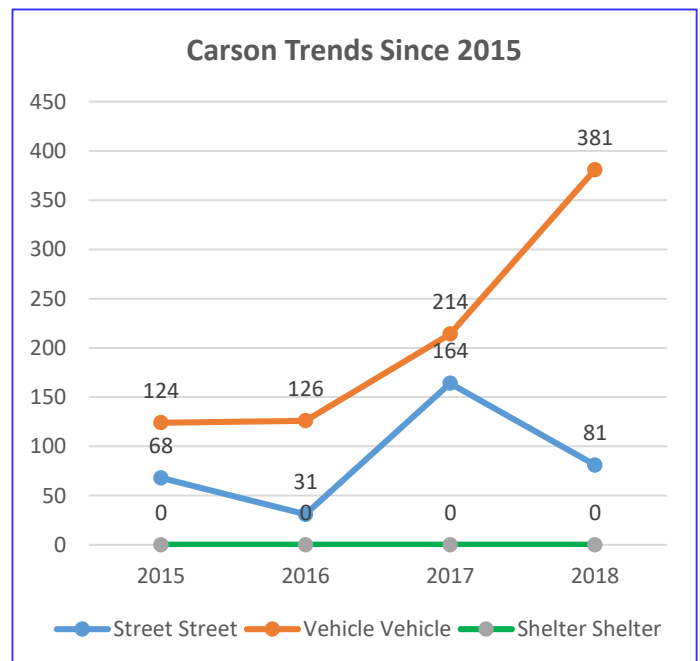
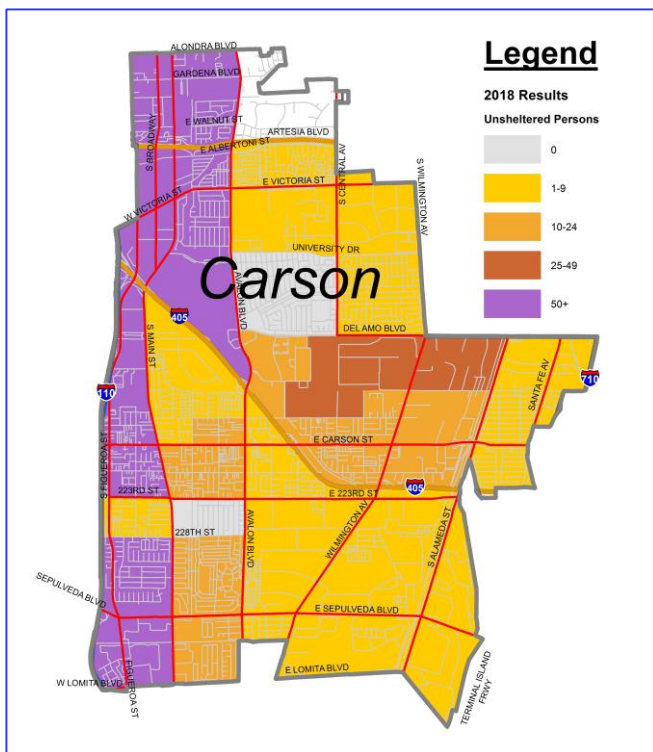
**462 Persons Experiencing Homelessness on January 24, 2018**

### Fast Facts

- Vehicular homelessness continues to play a major factor in Carson's homelessness, rising 78% from 2017.
- The Greater Carson area, consisting of Carson, Unincorporated West Carson, and Unincorporated Compton, comprise 25% of SPA 8's total unsheltered population. This is up from 2017 (20%) and 2016 (12%).
