
Fast Facts


- In 2016 and 2017, a Gardena DPSS office issued motel vouchers, which are considered "Emergency Shelter" stays. Beginning in 2018, these are reported at the regional level instead.
- Factoring out these motel vouchers, overall homelessness in Gardena was:
 - ... In 2015: 59
 - ... In 2016: 133
 - ... In 2017: 76
 - ... In 2018: 47
