
Fast Facts


- Harbor City's total fairly constant despite large encampments in adjacent unincorporated West Carson.
- City of Los Angeles CD15 overall homelessness (in the South Bay neighborhoods) decreased by 7% in 2018.
- City of Los Angeles "Vehicle Dwelling" Ordnance 85.02 was in effect for the full year.
