


Fast Facts

- ➤ The emergency shelter program is for unaccompanied minor aged children (e.g., runaways).
- ➤ For the Beach Cities consisting of El Segundo, Manhattan Beach, Hermosa Beach and Redondo Beach, unsheltered homelessness decreased from 307 in 2017 to 230 in 2018.
