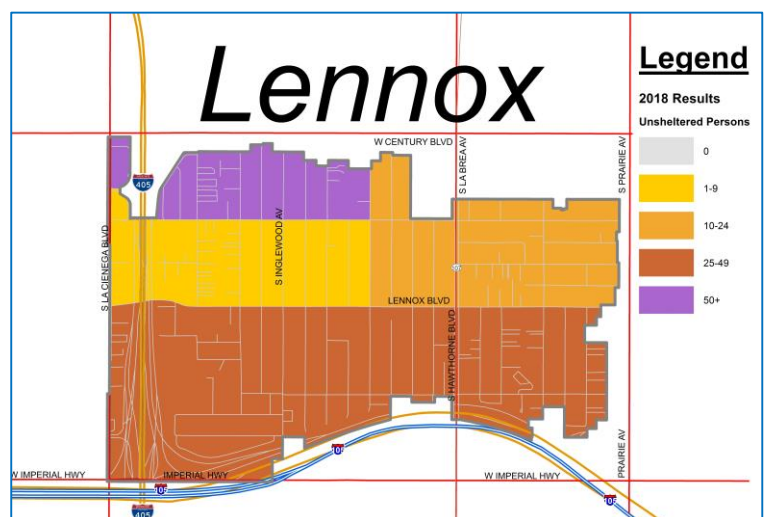
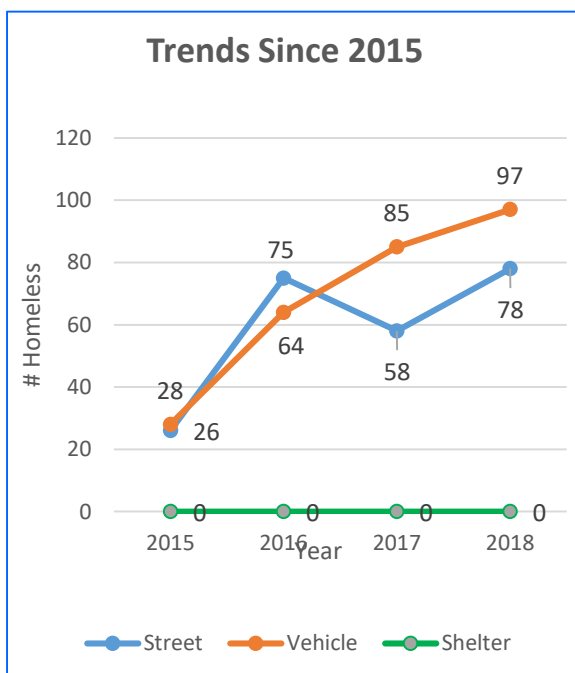
Lennox (Unincorporated LA County) 175 Persons Experiencing Homelessness on January 24, 2018
