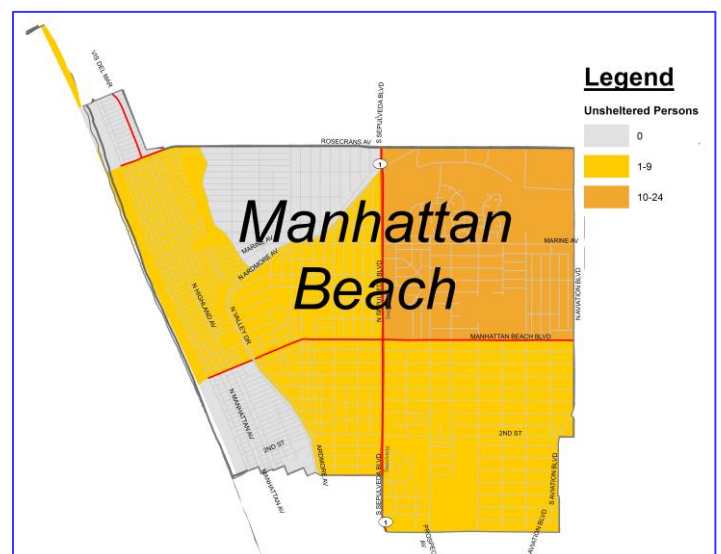
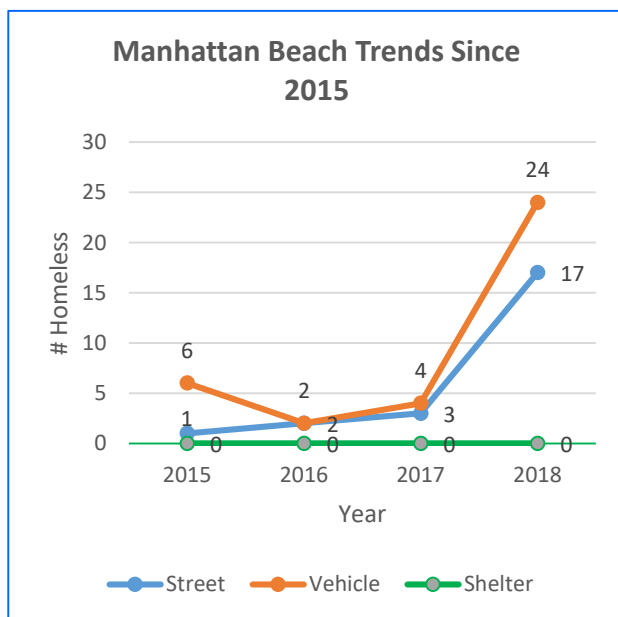
Fast Factx

- Homelessness was found in Manhattan Beach along the major retail areas.
- For the Beach Cities consisting of El Segundo, Manhattan Beach, Hermosa Beach and Redondo Beach, unsheltered homelessness decreased from 307 in 2017 to 230 in 2018.
