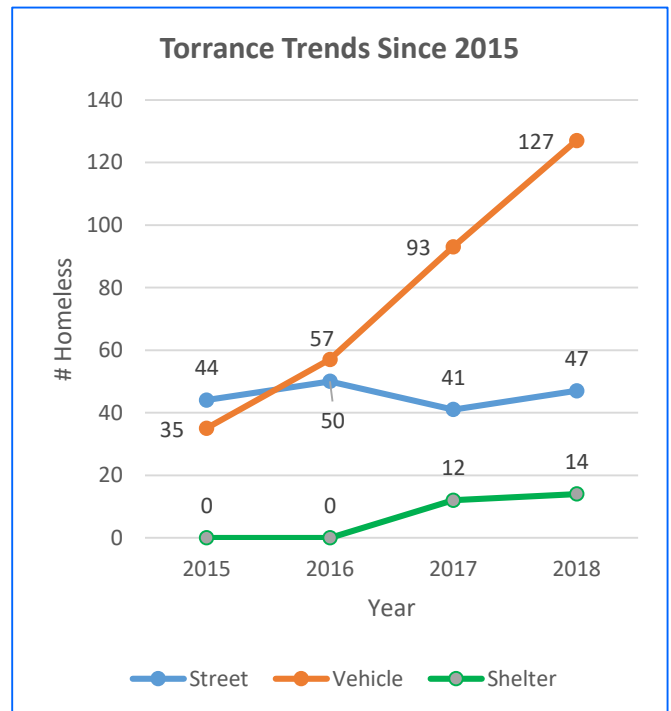
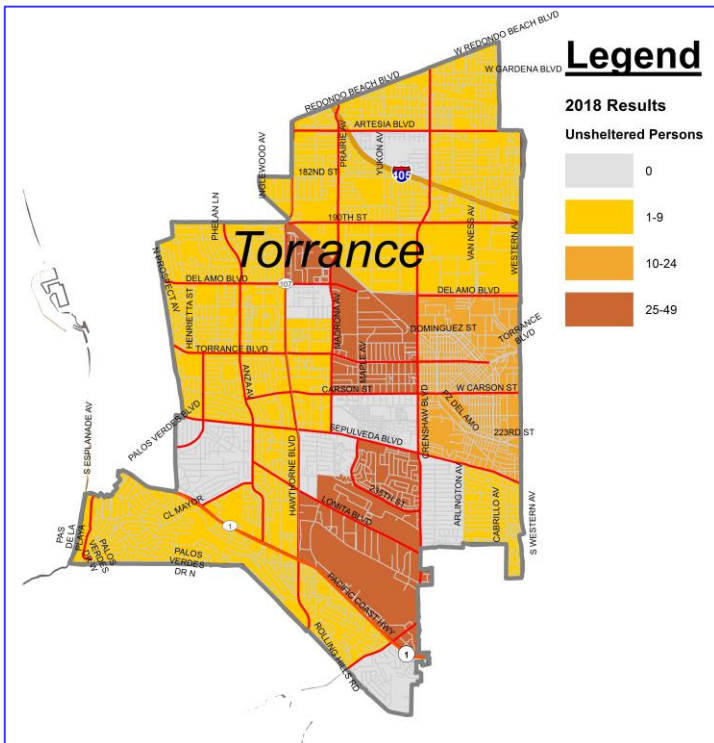
Fast Fact
