
Fast Facts

- The number of people in make-shift shelters and tents rose by 217% from last year.
- The Greater Carson area, consisting of Carson, Unincorporated West Carson, and Unincorporated Compton, comprise 25% of SPA 8's total unsheltered population. This is up from 2017 (20%) and 2016 (12%).
