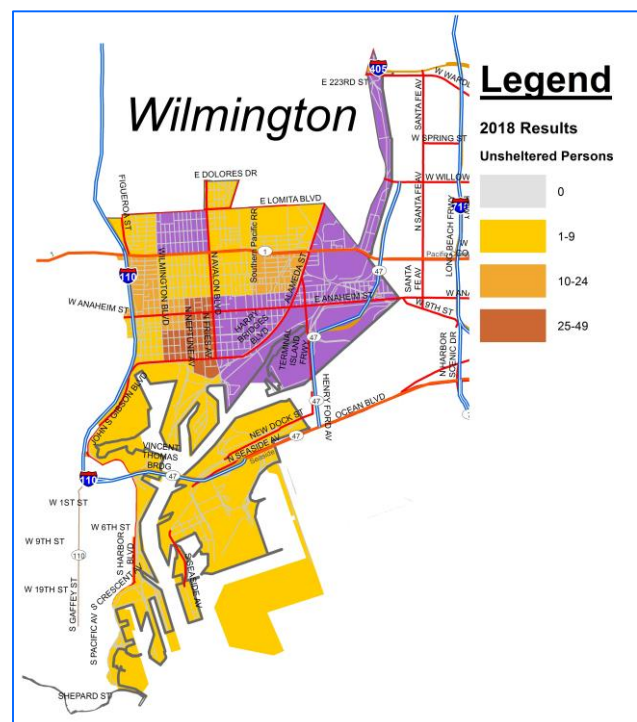
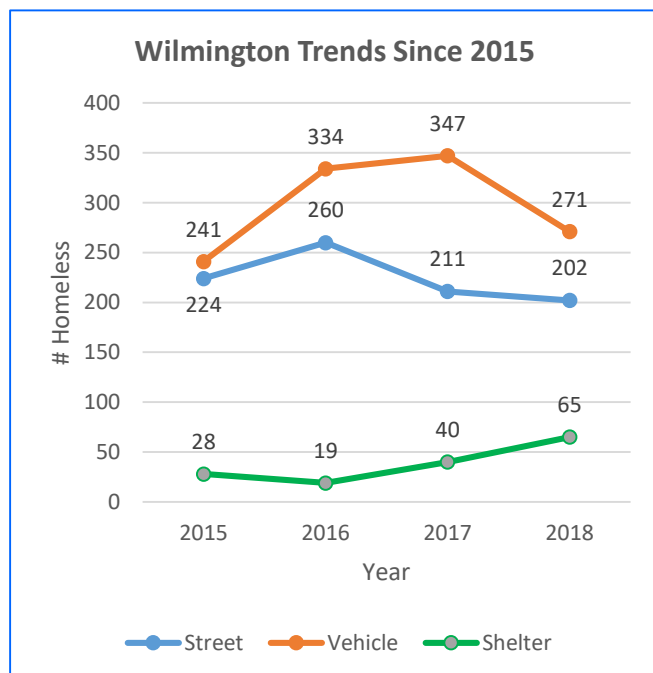
Wilmington (City of Los Angeles) 538 Persons Experiencing Homelessness on January 24, 2018

Fast Facts

- Vehicular homelessness declined by 22%, and overall homelessness by 10% on 2018.
- City of Los Angeles CD15 overall homelessness (in the South Bay neighborhoods) decreased by 7% in 2018.
- City of Los Angeles “Vehicle Dwelling” Ordinance 85.02 was in effect for the full year.
