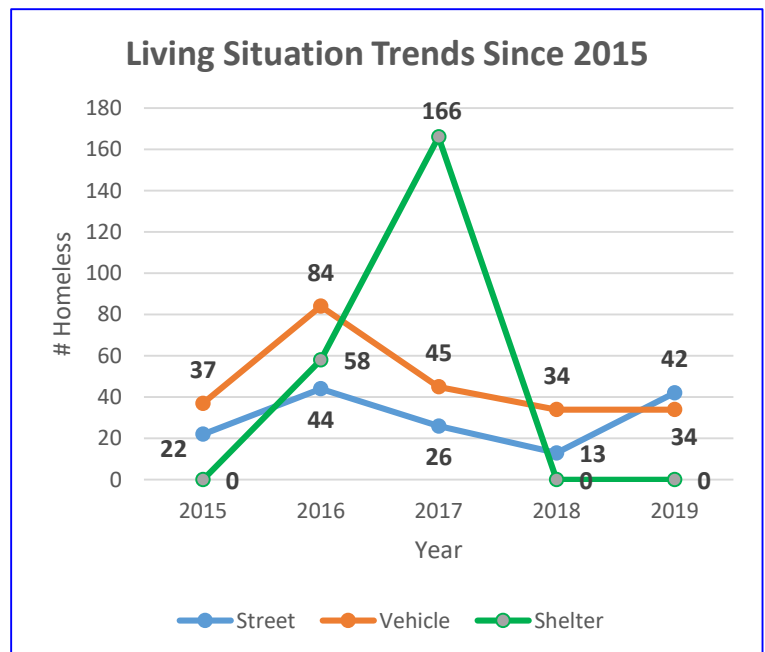
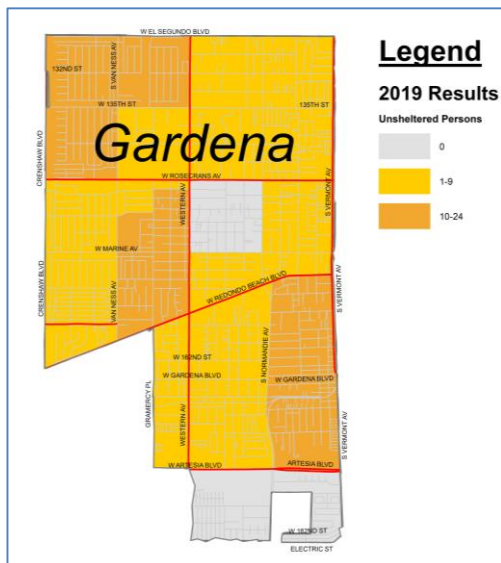
## City of Gardena

76 Persons Experiencing Homelessness on January 23, 2019

### Change since 2018

- In 2016 and 2017, a Gardena DPSS office issued motel vouchers, which are considered “Emergency Shelter” stays. Beginning in 2018, that data is now reported at the regional level instead.
- Factoring out these motel vouchers, overall homelessness in Gardena was:
  - ... In 2015: 59
  - ... In 2016: 133
  - ... In 2017: 76
  - ... In 2018: 47
  - ... in 2019: 76

### Notes

1. In 2019, LAHSA changed the city/neighborhood boundaries then retroactively applied these to the 2016-2018 Counts. The table and graph reflect the original Count results reported for those years, and hence may be different from LAHSA’s Community data.
2. Beginning in 2018, Unaccompanied Minors on the Street were reported at the SPA level rather than at the city level.
3. Youth Count numbers, DPSS issued motel vouchers, and domestic violence shelters are reported at the SPA level rather.
