Harbor Gateway Neighborhood (City of Los Angeles) 280 Persons Experiencing Homelessness on January 23, 2019


Change since 2018

 Unsheltered homelessness in the South Bay part of LA City Council District 15 rose by 32% (from 1,306 to 1,723). Unsheltered street homelessness rose there by 43%, while vehicular homelessness rose by 41%.
