



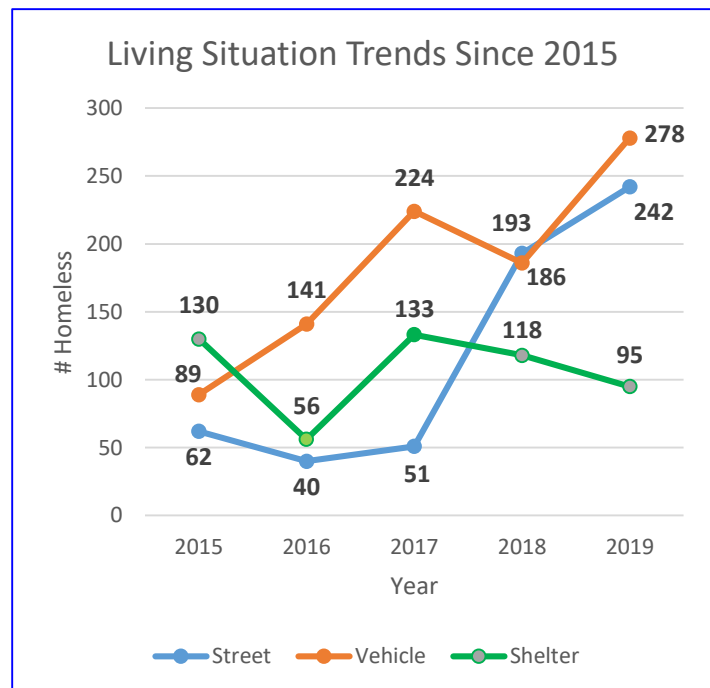
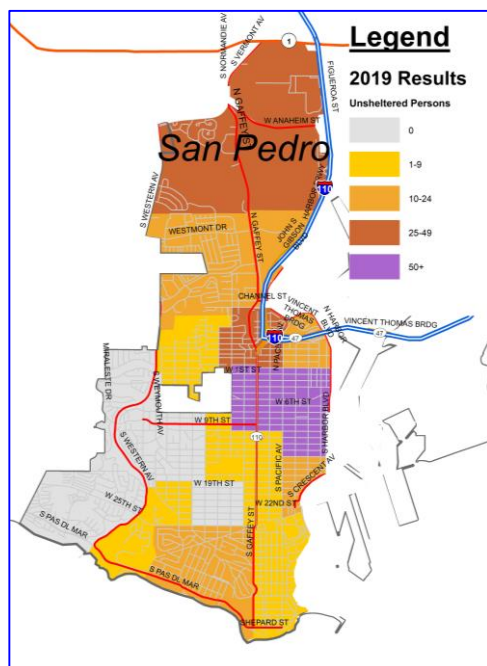
2019 Greater Los Angeles Homeless Count

San Pedro Neighborhood (City of Los Angeles) 615 Persons Experiencing Homelessness on January 23, 2019

Changes since 2018

- San Pedro's unsheltered street homelessness total rose by 25%, while vehicular homelessness rose by 49%.
- Unsheltered homelessness in the South Bay's part of LA City Council District 15 rose by 3 2% (from 1,306 to 1,723). Unsheltered street homelessness rose there by 43%, while vehicular homelessness rose by 41%.
