



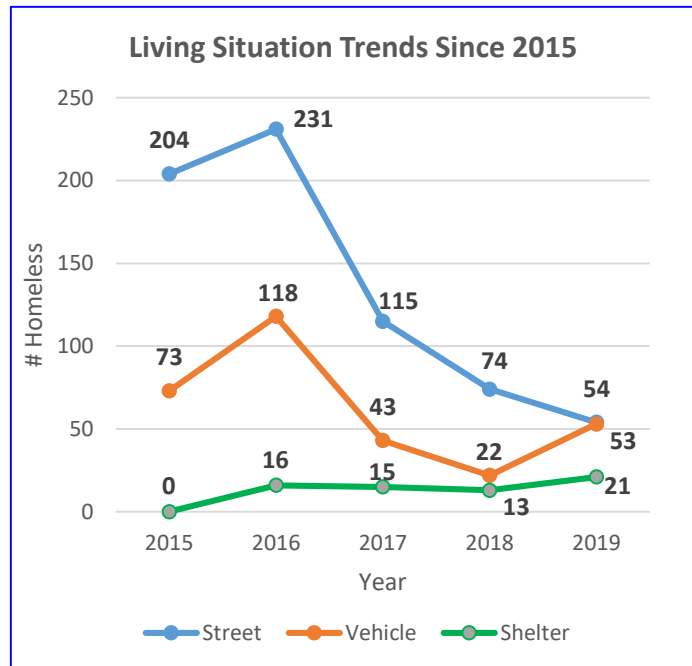
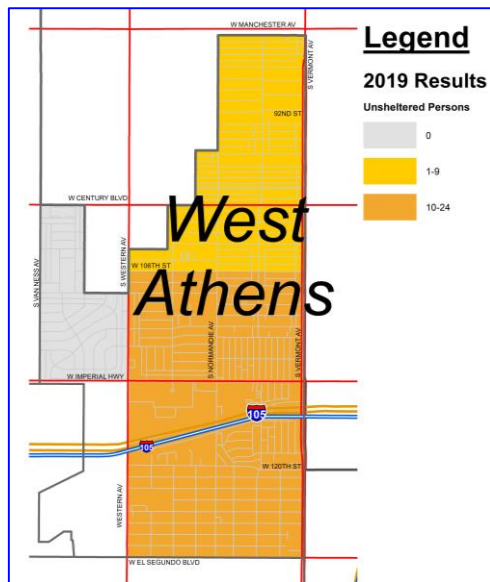
# 2019 Greater Los Angeles Homeless Count

## Unincorporated Westmont/West Athens 128 Persons Experiencing Homelessness on January 23, 2019

### Changes since 2018

- Overall homelessness rose by 17%.
- Vehicular homelessness rose by 141%, driven by the increase number of RVs.
