



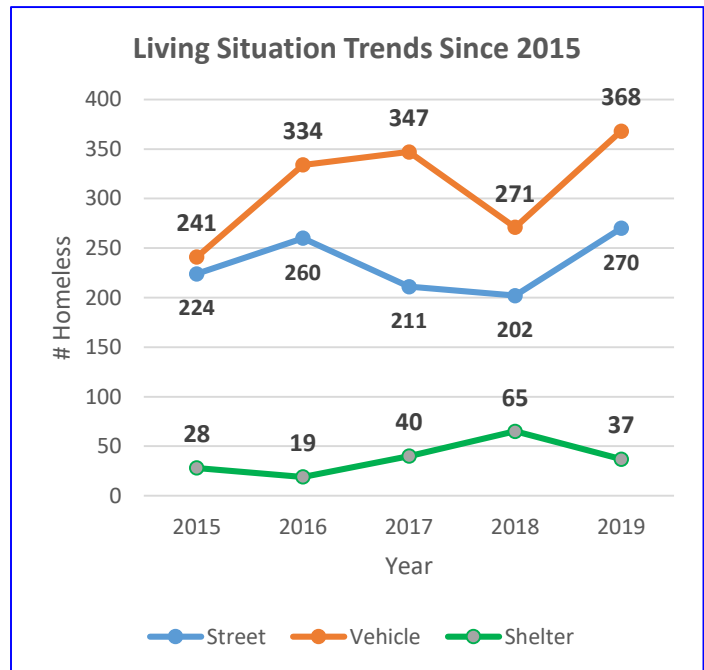
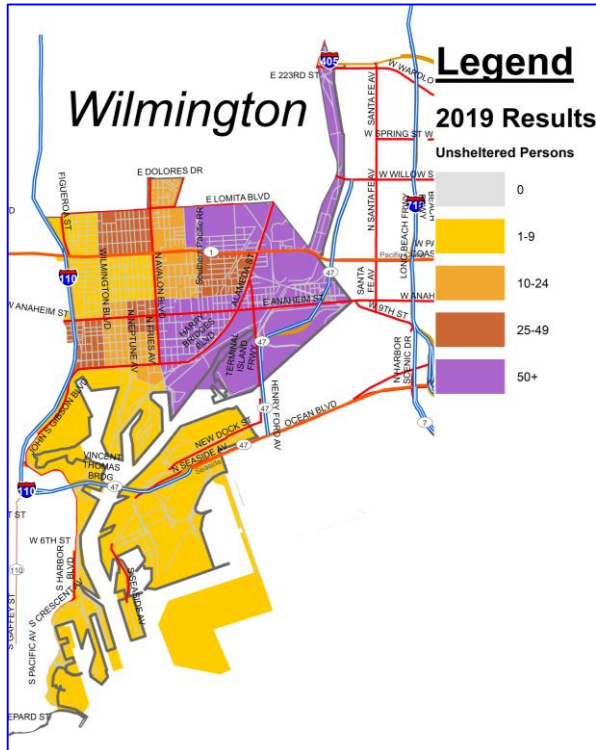
2019 Greater Los Angeles Homeless Count

Wilmington Neighborhood (City of Los Angeles) 675 Persons Experiencing Homelessness on January 23, 2019

Changes since 2018

- Wilmington's street homelessness total rose by 34% since 2018, while vehicular homelessness rose by 36%.
- Unsheltered homelessness in Los Angeles City Council District 15 neighborhoods located in the South Bay rose by 32% (from 1,306 to 1,723). Unsheltered street homelessness rose by 43% and vehicular homelessness rose by 41%.
