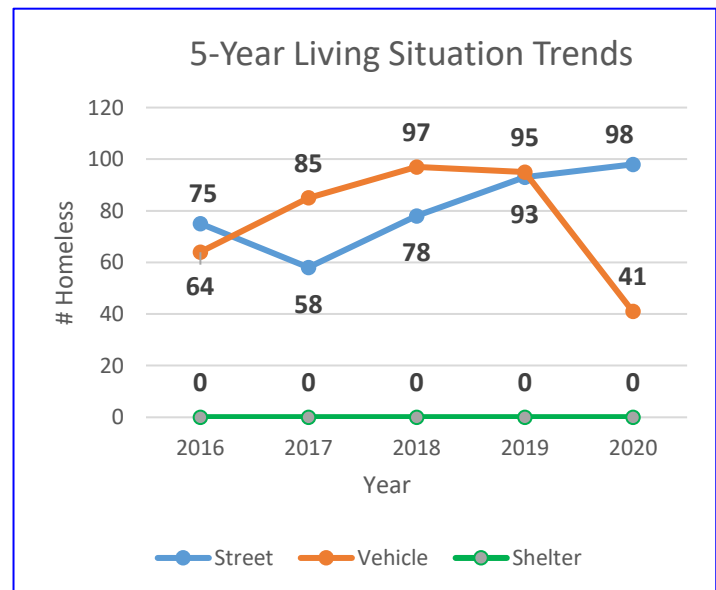
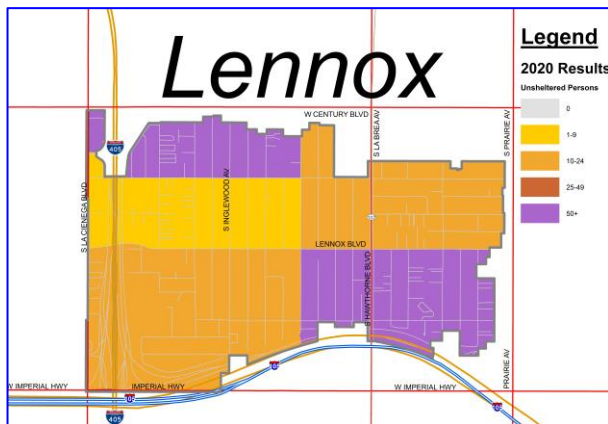
139 Persons Experiencing Homelessness on January 22, 2020

Changes since 2019

- Vehicular homelessness decreased by -57%, with significant reductions in cars, vans, and RVs.

1. In 2019, LAHSA changed the city/neighborhood boundaries and then retroactively applied these to the 2016-2018 Counts. SBCEH rounds the data differently than LAHSA, which might also result in slightly different reporting numbers.
