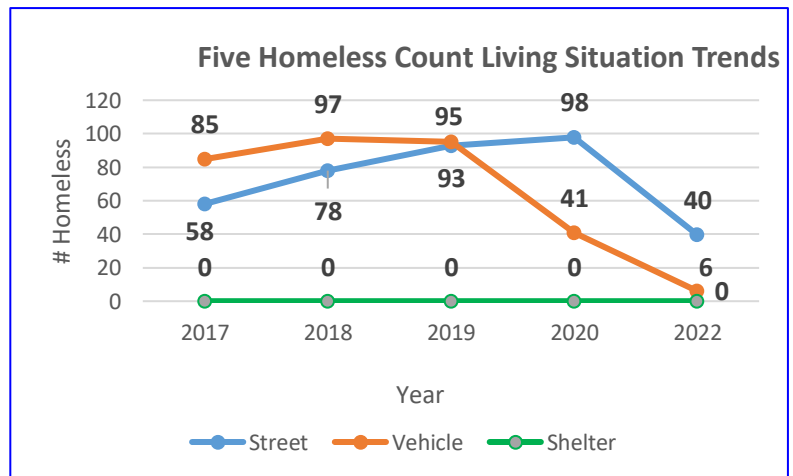
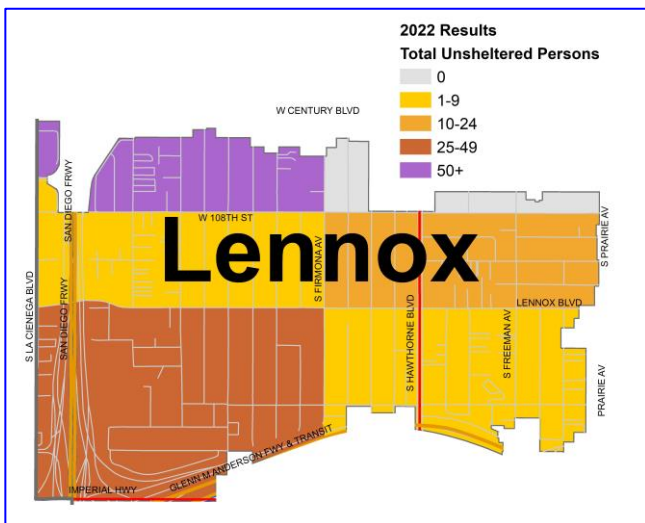

Note about 2022

- The numbers presented reflect LAHSA's official findings. However, unofficially, St. Margaret's Center, which completed the census for all these tracts, reported finding the following:
 - Individuals (over 24): 35
 - # Cars: 13
 - # Campers/RV's: 20
 - # Tents: 36
 - # Makeshift shelters: 16
 - SBCEH calculates this would result in a minimum of 171 persons.

- Notes**
- In 2019, LAHSA changed the city/neighborhood boundaries and then retroactively applied these to the 2016-2018 Counts. The table and graph reflect the original Count results reported for those years, and hence may be different from LAHSA's Community data. SBCEH rounds the data differently than LAHSA, which might also result in slightly different reporting numbers.
 - The following results are reported at the SPA level only: Domestic Violence Shelters, Youth Count results, and DPSS-issued motel vouchers.
 - Unaccompanied Minors on the Street data is only available at the SPA/Regional level.
 - The 2021 unsheltered count was canceled because of the COVID-19 pandemic. The 2022 was delayed one month because of the Omicron variant surge.
