SENIOR (CSFP) food program third Tuesday of month. **9-11 am.**

HOMELESS

COORDINATED ENTRY SYSTEM (CES):

Outreach, case management, and housing navigation assistance program for homeless individuals.

SHOWER PROGRAM

Free showers with Showers of Hope.

Free haircuts periodically.

Mondays, 9am – 1pm.

People experiencing homelessness can use the Center for their mailing address

EDUCATION

ESL CLASSES

Small, intensive daily classes for those who would like to improve their English language skills. Begins Oct. 2021

LITERACY TUTORING

One-on-one virtual tutoring for literacy or basic reading, writing, math and computer skills, for adults and youth.

CITIZENSHIP CLASSES

Monday and Wednesday afternoon classes for those who are preparing for their citizenship interview.

NUTRITION EDUCATION PROGRAM

One-on-one and group educational sessions encouraging good nutrition, healthy habits, physical activity and disease prevention. Free yoga classes Thursdays at 4 pm. Walking club Fridays at 10 am. Community garden development at St. Margaret's Center and the local community.

EDUCATIONAL WORKSHOPS

Community workshops are held periodically at the Center with topics of interest for low-income households, e.g. parenting, health, finances, nutrition, etc.

HEALTH & WELLNESS

VISION SCREENING

Periodic free eye exams provided by the UCLA Mobile Eye Clinic.

MOBILE MEDICAL

CLINICS: Venice Family Clinic, provides clinical services to homeless clients, Mon 9 – 2pm, Claris Mobile Clinic, periodically

COUNSELING SERVICES

Available with supervised interns. Sliding fee scale based on income. Spanish-language counseling also available. **Clients call (310) 258-9677**, ask for SMC's wait list when appointment is made.

HEALTH INSURANCE

APPLICATION ASSISTANCE

Information and free application assistance for low-cost and free health insurance programs. MediCal, Covered California and other programs. **By appointment only.**

SOCIAL SUPPORT

IMMIGRATION PROCESSING

Low-cost immigration processing (petitions for relatives, citizenship, renewal of green cards, DACA, adjustment of status, etc.) Mon & Thu, by appointment only.

DIAPER PROGRAM

Free diapers once a month for eligible babies and toddlers, by appointment.

UTILITY ASSISTANCE

Payment up to \$100 for Gas and Edison bills, when funding available.

INFORMATION & REFERRAL Information and referrals to free or low-cost services, e.g. legal, medical, housing, employment, government programs. Advocacy with government assistance programs.
